



Call for applications for the 3rd Junior Economists Meeting (UniMI-JEM24)

The JEM is a yearly workshop organised by the University of Milan that offers a unique opportunity for Ph.D. students and early-career researchers working on **applied topics** (applied micro, experimental and behavioural economics) to present and discuss their work.

The 3rd edition of the workshop will take place in Milan on the **16th and 17th of May 2024** and will feature a keynote speech by Prof. **Giovanni Peri** (UC Davis) on «**Measuring and Predicting “New Work”: The Role of Local Factors and Global Trends**».

Applicants should apply by sending a **complete draft** through the submission form below before the 8th of March.

There is **no conference fee**. Invited speakers can apply for **financial assistance for accommodation and travel expenses**. Participants will only be eligible to receive financial assistance if they have indicated this in the application form. Presentations will last for 30 minutes and will be followed by a 10-minute discussion and a 5-minute Q&A. The event will begin around 2 pm on Thursday (May 16th) and end around 5 pm on Friday (May 17th).
